Just a short flight away is the town of Flores and the magnificent Mayan ruins of Tikal, it's soaring ancient temples rising from the jungle floor.

## **JAN 23 ROATAN, HONDURAS**

On the southern edge of the world's second largest barrier reef, Roatan is celebrated for its superb snorkeling and diving, but its shoreside offerings are similarly marvelous. The island boasts magnificent beaches, tropical forests and spectacular volcanic rocks.
