# Reunion Weekend 2015 - Parking and Shuttle Information

## Thursday, May 7

### PARKING

**Classes of '55 and '60** going to The Carolina Club (Alumni Center): you may first look for available and free parking (after 5 p.m.) on Stadium Drive. If Stadium Drive is full, we recommend you park in Rams Head Parking Deck located on Ridge Road (applicable hourly fees apply).

SHUTTLES for '55 and '60: There will be shuttle pickups from only Granville Towers to the Alumni Center between 5:30 – 6 p.m. Return shuttle service back to Granville Towers from the Alumni Center will also be offered at the conclusion of each dinner.

**Class of '65, '70 or others** going to the Ackland Art Museum: The Ackland does not have a private, dedicated parking lot. The Swain Lot (see map) will be available for a fee, or you may find other parking available in nearby University lots at no cost after 5 p.m. Convenient parking is also available at several nearby Chapel Hill municipal and private parking decks (most with entrances off Rosemary Street). Please call the GAA at (919) 843-0446 if you wish to have further detailed recommendations.

## Friday, May 8

### PARKING

**All participants:** Prior to 5 p.m., please park in Rams Head Parking Deck located on Ridge Road next door to the Alumni Center. There will be a parking fee set by the UNC Department of Public Safety. There is a walkway on Level 3 of the deck that will bring you toward the Alumni Center. There will be signs to help guide you.

After 5 p.m., you may find available parking on Stadium Drive or other nearby University lots at no cost; otherwise spaces will be available in Rams Head Parking Deck for applicable fees.

SHUTTLES: **Shuttles will assist getting participants as close as possible to any reunion event site all day** with consistent stops at the Alumni Center Circle (just outside the main building entrance) and Granville Towers.

- First shuttle will begin with a pick up at Granville Towers at 8:30 a.m.
- Last shuttle will depart from the Alumni Center at 8:15 p.m.

## Saturday, May 9

### PARKING

**Before 5 p.m. (all participants):** You may find available parking on Stadium Drive or other nearby University lots at no cost; otherwise spaces will be available in Rams Head Parking Deck for applicable fees.

**Class of '65** going to The Carolina Inn: Paid valet parking may be available by the Inn (while space lasts). **The Nash Lot has been reserved for the event at no cost** (see map on reverse: turn on Wilson Street off of Cameron Boulevard for access to Nash Lot). Information about additional parking options will be provided in reunion packets upon check-in. Another option is that you may park on Stadium Drive or at Rams Head Parking Deck and take a GAA Reunion Shuttle to The Carolina Inn.

**Class of '70** going to The Carolina Club (Alumni Center) after 5 p.m.: you may first look for available and free parking on Stadium Drive. If Stadium Drive is full, we recommend you park in Rams Head Parking Deck located on Ridge Road (applicable hourly fees apply).

SHUTTLES: **Shuttles will assist getting participants as close as possible to any reunion event site all day** with consistent stops at the Alumni Center Circle (just outside the main building entrance) and Granville Towers.

- First shuttle will pick up at the Alumni Center at 8 a.m.
- Last shuttle will depart from The Carolina Inn at the conclusion of the '65 dance or 11 p.m. (whichever is first)

## Sunday, May 10

### PARKING

**Class of '65** members who are registered for the 50<sup>th</sup> Reunion Commencement Procession will receive special reserved parking instructions and permit at reunion check-in.

SHUTTLES: GAA reunion campus shuttles **will not** operate on Sunday.
