Reunion Weekend 2016 - Parking and Shuttle Information

Thursday, May 5

PARKING

For those attending "The Storied South" enrichment session at Graham Memorial: There may be spaces available in the Morehead Planetarium visitors parking lot (entrance off Franklin Street, located on the backside of Graham Memorial) at regular hourly rates. If that lot is full, we recommend parking in one of the parking decks in Chapel Hill (e.g. there are two decks located about 3 blocks away with entrances off Rosemary Street); regular pay rates will apply.

For class of '66 Opening Reception at Graham Memorial: There may be a few spaces available in the Morehead Planetarium visitors parking lot (entrance off Franklin Street, located on the backside of Graham Memorial) at regular hourly rates. Beginning at 5 p.m. **the Bynum Lot on campus has been reserved for our attendees at no cost** (see map). Simply tell attendant at entrance to the lot that you are attending the reunion reception.

Classes of '51, '56 and '61 going to The Carolina Inn: Paid valet parking may be available by the Inn (while space lasts). The Nash Lot has been reserved for our attendees at no cost (see map on reverse: turn on Wilson Street off of Cameron Boulevard for access to Nash Lot).

Friday, May 6

PARKING

All participants: Prior to 5 p.m., please park in Rams Head Parking Deck located on Ridge Road next door to the Alumni Center. There will be a parking fee set by the UNC Department of Public Safety. There is a walkway on Level 3 of the deck that will bring you toward the Alumni Center. There will be signs to help guide you.

After 5 p.m., you may find available parking on Stadium Drive or other nearby University lots at no cost; otherwise spaces will be available in Rams Head Parking Deck for applicable fees. Please note that there is a baseball game which begins at 6 p.m. which will add to traffic and parking congestion in the area.

SHUTTLES: Shuttles will assist getting participants as close as possible to any reunion event site all day with consistent stops at the Alumni Center Circle (just outside the main building entrance) and Stacey/Everett Dorms.

- First shuttle will begin with a pick up at Stacey/Everett at 9 a.m.
 - Last shuttle will depart from the Alumni Center at 9:45 p.m.

Saturday, May 7

PARKING

Before 5 p.m. (all participants): You may find available parking on Stadium Drive or other nearby University lots at no cost; otherwise spaces will be available in Rams Head Parking Deck for applicable fees. Please note that there is a baseball game which begins at 1 p.m. which will add to traffic and parking congestion in the area.

Class of '66 going to The Carolina Club (Alumni Center) for Saturday night banquet: You may find available parking on Stadium Drive or other nearby University lots at no cost; otherwise spaces will be available in Rams Head Parking Deck for applicable fees.

SHUTTLES: Shuttles will assist getting participants as close as possible to any reunion event site all day with consistent stops at the Alumni Center Circle (just outside the main building entrance) and Stacey/Everett dorms.

- First shuttle will pick up at the Alumni Center at 8:45 a.m.
- Last shuttle will depart from The Alumni Center at 11:15 p.m.
