**Ritchie Kendall**  
coordinates the selection of Honors Carolina students and is responsible for Honors course programming and

extracurricular activities. He is an award-winning English professor who has served as Director of Undergraduate Studies, Director of Graduate Studies, and Assistant Chair of the Department of English and Comparative Literature. He led the inaugural Honors London Semester Abroad and has directed the program three times since. He is the author of *The Drama of Dissent*, an investigation of late medieval and Renaissance religious nonconformists and their uneasy relationship with contemporary theater. Currently, he is completing a book manuscript, *Funny Business: Telling Stories of Economic Innovation and Change*. The study examines a range of emergent economic activities in England and America, beginning in the late sixteenth century and concluding with Hollywood responses to the merger and acquisition scandals of the 80's and the financial collapse of 2008. Discussing artists from Shakespeare and Marlowe to Daniel Defoe to Charles Dickens to Oliver Stone, the book explores cultural excitement and anxiety about major shifts in wealth production and the disruptive social changes they engender. Dean Kendall earned his undergraduate degree from Yale, and then master's and PhD degrees at Harvard.

Professor Kendall will accompany the tour with a minimum of 10 participants.

**Discovery: Bath—A City of History and Heritage.** Trace rich Roman and Georgian history as you discover the well-preserved city of Bath, a UNESCO World Heritage site along the River Avon. Bath was built around the only natural hot spring in Great Britain, and the city was originally an exclusive spa getaway for European aristocrats. View the Roman Baths, and see the remnants of an ancient heating system at the museum. Learn about typical features of these public facilities, then admire Bath Abbey, Pulteney Bridge and the 18th-century Georgian Royal Crescent.

**Free Time:** Make your own discoveries in Bath. You may wish to relax at the Thermae Bath Spa or visit the Jane Austen Centre.



#### **Longleat | Stourhead**

**Enrichment: England's Stately Homes and**



**Gardens.** English estates are markers of former wealth and power and each has a story to tell. This morning, listen to narratives about the privileged owners of some of these grand properties.

#### **Discovery: A Day of Living Graciously.**

England's stately homes are a true delight to behold. Admire the Tudor façade and lavish interior of Longleat, which is modeled after estates in Venice and Genoa. Outside, the grounds feature Europe's longest hedge maze and gardens designed by Capability Brown. Travel to Stourhead, a National Trust estate, to stroll the 18th-century Arcadian-designed gardens. The sprawling grounds have waterfalls, statuary and temples dedicated to Apollo and Flora.

Join your fellow travelers for lunch at a nearby establishment.

#### **Bath | Port Isaac | Falmouth**

After breakfast, depart for your full-day transfer to Falmouth. Journey near undulating valleys, genteel

villages and craggy coastlines—a quintessential vision of rural England.

**Discovery: To the Corner of Cornwall.**

Discover the nautical ambience of Port Isaac, an authentic fishing village featured in the British TV series *Doc Martin*. During your walking tour, take note of the historical buildings, whitewashed cottages and cobbled lanes, and learn about the village's maritime history.

**Free Time:** Take advantage of leisure time to bask in the harbor's tranquil ambience, or seek the village's narrowest thoroughfare, Squeezey Belly Alley.

Depart Port Isaac to visit the Bedruthan Steps, a product of Mother Nature's magnificent force. Local myth suggests that the stacked stones along the beach were once stepping stones used by the giant Bedruthan. See this curious wonder for yourself and draft your own lore about its creation.

Continue to Falmouth, and check in to the Merchants Manor hotel.

**Enrichment: Corners of Cornwall and**

**Devon.** A local expert shares chronicles of British mining and how the ores of Cornwall and Devon influenced Britain's Industrial Revolution.

**Discovery: Maritime and Mining.** Delight in the windswept beaches and 16-century castle along Pendennis Point during a panoramic

tour. In downtown Falmouth, learn more about Cornwall's maritime heritage during a visit to the National Maritime Museum Cornwall. Browse exhibits, interactive displays and photographs to uncover myths of intrepid explorers, and learn about the evolution of boat designs while viewing a collection of boats, from muscle-powered to engine-powered.

Dine with your group at a local establishment.


Depart for Heartlands, part of the Cornwall and West Devon Mining Landscape UNESCO World Heritage site. Situated on 19 acres, this cultural park is steeped in industrial heritage. Learn about the region's impressive mining history through state-of-the-art exhibitions and galleries, and stroll the botanical gardens.

**St. Ives | Marazion**

**Discovery: Cornwall.** Experience myriad

treasures along the Cornish coast. The landscape of old fishing villages, thatched cottages and rolling meadows is truly awe-inspiring. Discover the highlights of St. Ives during an introductory tour. This trendy haven for artists and entrepreneurs will delight you with its many art galleries and cozy cafés.

**Free Time:** Indulge in leisure time in St. Ives. You may choose to visit the Barbara Hepworth Museum and Sculpture Garden or simply watch ornery seagulls soar by Godrevy Lighthouse.

Continue to Marazion, one of Britain's oldest towns. Walk across the cobbled causeway or hop on a boat for a ride to St. Michael's Mount. This fortress-like ancient abbey was built by Benedictine monks and dedicated to St. Michael the Archangel. Take time to explore the abbey and appreciate the island's sub-tropical gardens.

### Falmouth | Plymouth | Exeter

Following breakfast, transfer to Exeter via Plymouth.

**Discovery: Nautical Plymouth and a Taste of Gin.** Plymouth welcomes visitors with its vibrant history and stunning natural harbor. This popular ocean city is recognized as the

home seaport for many renowned sea-faring adventurers—three of Captain Cook's voyages sailed from here. See the Mayflower Steps that celebrate the Pilgrim Fathers' point of departure aboard the Mayflower in 1620. Then learn more about this epic journey to the New World during your visit to the Mayflower Museum.

Relax over lunch in a Plymouth restaurant.

Tour the Plymouth Gin Distillery, England's oldest working gin distillery. Originally built as a monastery, the distillery has been producing gin in the same still for over 150 years and uses water that comes from Dartmoor National Park. Enjoy tasting the smooth flavors and unique ingredients, including juniper berries, lemon peel and cardamom. The original 1793 recipe is still used today!

Continue to Exeter and check in to the Mercure Exeter Southgate Hotel.

### Exeter

**Discovery: The Heart of Exeter.** Meet a knowledgeable Red Coat Guide and embark on a walking tour through Exeter's "Old and New." Listen to tales of the city's historical past as you stroll past significant buildings and hidden treasures.

**Free Time:** Join the Elective Activity this afternoon, or enjoy free time in Exeter.

#### **ELECTIVE | Dartmoor National Park.**

Explore the rugged beauty of Dartmoor National Park, a landscape dotted with ancient woodlands, gurgling streams and miniature Dartmoor ponies, which are descendants of the Celtic pony. Learn about Dartmoor's unique

heritage at the visitors center, and visit the community of Widecombe-in-the-Moor and the Devon Guild of Craftsmen, an art center with handmade gifts and contemporary crafts.

**Day Ten** B | L

**Exeter | Salisbury | London**

Following breakfast, depart for London via Salisbury. Your journey takes you through rural settlements, heaths, woodlands and chalky hillsides.

**Discovery: Salisbury.** Visit Salisbury, Wiltshire’s only city, known for its lively arts community and tangle of small lanes. Tour the 13th-century Salisbury Cathedral, one of Europe’s most celebrated cathedrals. Its spire stretches to a lofty 404 feet, the tallest in England. See the cathedral’s Magna Carta, one of only four surviving original copies, and walk through an interactive exhibit.

After lunch, continue to London and check in to the Radisson Blu Edwardian, Vanderbilt.

**Enrichment: London—Past and Present.** Discover London’s fascinating past and the role this capital city played in England’s rich history and the former British Empire.

**Free Time:** Spend your final day at leisure in London. Looking for more history? Head to the Tower of London or Churchill’s War Rooms. London also has some of the world’s best



museums, including the British Museum and the Victoria & Albert Museum.

Tonight, gather for a Farewell Reception and Dinner at the hotel, and share your favorite moments and adventures from your program.






