

COVERED BUTTON PUSH PINS AND MAGNETS

These tiny bundles of Carolina joy are both easy to make, and super useful.

SUPPLIES

- fabric
- craft cover button kit
- push pins with flat top
- magnets
- pencil
- scissors
- adhesive suitable for metal and plastic
(I used E6000 for this project)
- lining fabric, if needed



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Purchase craft cover button kit (size 45 was used) which includes:

- a. buttons
- b. plain backs
- c. shank backs
- d. template
- e. tools



2. Using a pencil, trace around the outside of the circle template onto your fabric. You can use the inside circle to center a design. Cut out the circle.



3. Center the fabric, wrong-side-up in the button mold. Press the button into the mold. If your fabric is sheer, you may want to use a lining fabric. Adjust to center the design if necessary.



4. Fold all edges of the fabric to the center of the button mold.

5. Place the plain back over the fabric.



6. Place the pusher over the back and press hard. You will feel the back snap into place.
7. Glue the flat top push pin or the magnet to the back. You will need to use an adhesive suitable for metal and plastic. For this project, I used E6000 Adhesive.
