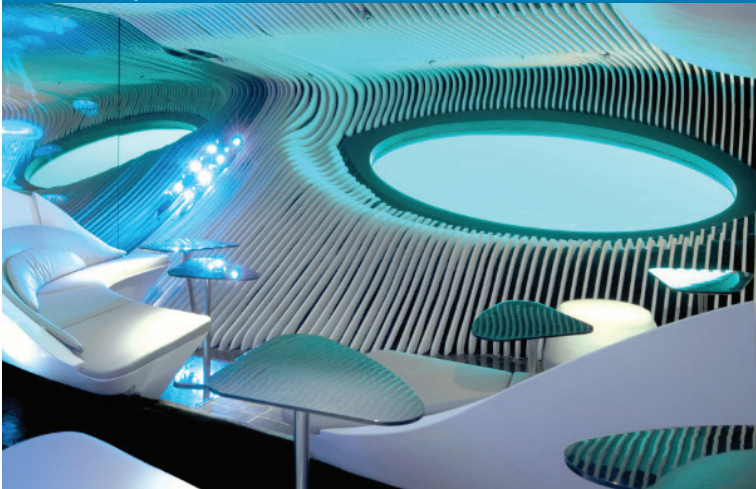

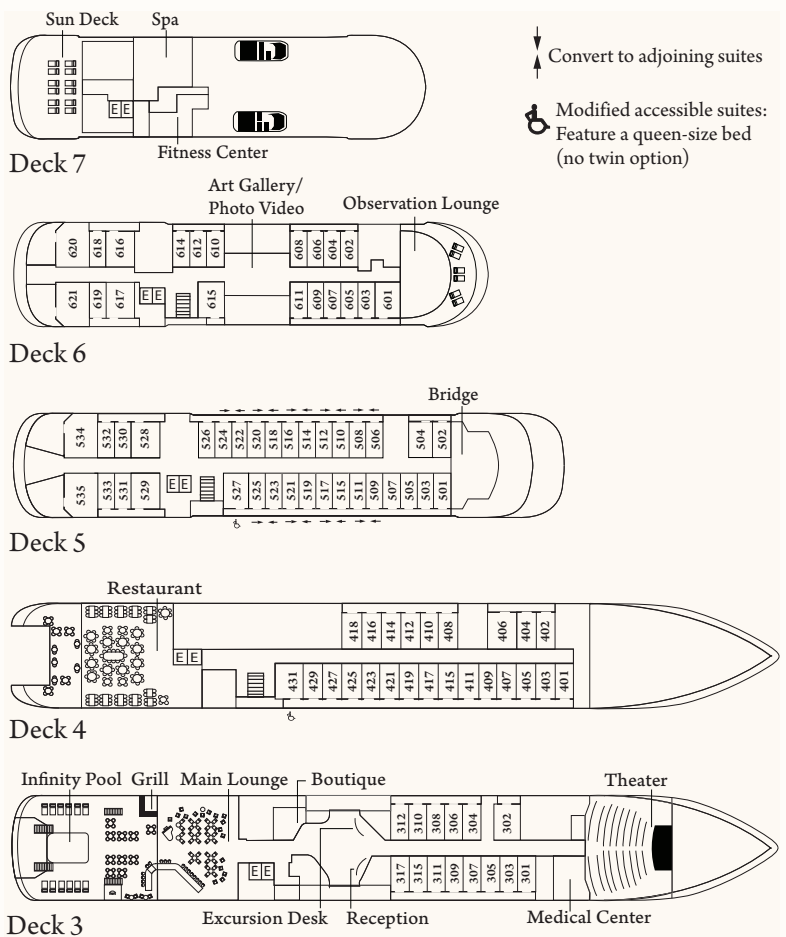
LIFE ON BOARD
